



Paul's Assurance of Salvation

Paul had no confidence in himself, but absolute confidence in God and His Son.

Paul knew that the Son of God came into the world to save sinners (1 Tim. 1:15), that He had come into the world not to condemn the world but through Him the world might be saved (John 3:17).



Paul knew that we are saved by grace through faith (Eph. 2:8) and not by works of righteousness that we ourselves have done (Tit. 3:5).

Paul knew that God was on the side of sinners and had purposed before the foundation of the world that they should be saved, and that He would do everything in His power to see that it was accomplished.

Paul knew that heaven was prepared for just such sinners as he himself had been, and we need to know that, too.

It is not God's intention that we should spend our days as Christians in constant uncertainty about our eternal destiny. If that were so how could Paul write that "the kingdom of heaven is not eating and drinking but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit"? (Rom. 14:17). How could he say that the fruit of the Spirit is "love, joy, peace ..."? (Gal. 5:22). If we are to have no assurance of heaven there can certainly be no peace and joy, but assurance resides not in our own worthiness but in what God has done and can do. So, if you want to go to heaven more than anything and have your heart set on doing the Lord's will above all else, that is exactly what you will do. For, as Paul wrote so triumphantly: "For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord" (Rom. 8:38–39).[1]





Our hearts go out to MARCIA JESTER, and her family, on the death of her father, **WAYNE ABBOTT**. His funeral was in Hope on Sunday.


