I want to use this space to issue a special invitation for you each to attend our Sunday evening series of lessons. We began a flyover last week of the New Testament in an attempt to get a bird's-eye view of the different writings that pertain to the new covenant God has made.

Earlier, we spent several weeks investigating daily life in the 1st Century and the various ways the writers of the New Testament used everyday events and social aspects of the culture to teach the new emerging community of Christians how to be followers of Christ. Those writers also reframed many of those social aspects and used them to teach spiritual lessons that are obviously important to God.

Last week we introduced the Gospel of Mark, which is believed by many to have chronologically been the first gospel written. In it we found testimony proclaiming the full authority and power of Christ as the Son of God, and we read how he provided the best model of sacrificial service we could ever observe and emulate.

Come fly with me tonight as we discuss the Gospel of Matthew and see how Jesus fits into the Jewish idea of the promised Messiah. Hope to see ya then!
