

The Stronghold

The Stronghold in ancient military times was known as a place that had been greatly fortified to protect against attack. Paul writes in 2 Corinthians 4:4 that Christians have access to weapons holding "divine power to destroy strongholds." You know how bold that statement is if you have seen pictures of those ancient strongholds and fortresses, but Paul's reference is to something that can be even stronger. He is writing about spiritual strongholds.



One author defines a spiritual stronghold as, "a mindset impregnated with hopelessness which causes us to accept, as unchangeable, situations we know are contrary to the will of God." I encourage you to have this definition in hand during the sermon this morning, and you would do well to keep it nearby all week long. Satan is surely at work every day building strongholds in our life, and far too often we accept his architecture and our mindset becomes one of hopelessness that is against God's will for us.

Paul says we don't have to accept what Satan builds; we can destroy even those spiritual strongholds and change things in our life. "For the weapons of our warfare are not of the flesh but have divine power to destroy strongholds. We destroy arguments and every lofty opinion raised against the knowledge of God, and take every thought captive to obey Christ," (2 Cor. 10:4–5)

I pray that over the next two weeks you find the knowledge and motivation to see the sinful strongholds in your life destroyed and replaced by the only true fortress that can protect and endure. "The Lord is a stronghold for the oppressed, a stronghold in times of trouble." (Psalm 9:9–10)

May God bless our every effort to reject Satan and draw closer to Him






Alyson White will be part of a Harding University Mission Team serving on a Navajo reservation at Kayenta, AZ, July 5-22. The Elders have contributed Mission
