Be A Healthy Hive



We have made it to the end of our Summer Series! The bees have taught us much about God, ourselves, and the church. I want to tell you again that I appreciate the encouragement, comments, and the many people who have told me how much they have enjoyed and learned from these lessons. I, too, have learned much to apply to my own life in our hive.

Our concluding lesson today will discuss hive inspection. Beekeepers don't just set up a hive and leave it be. Watching bees come and go from a distance can be helpful, but for a true and complete picture, it is important for the beekeeper to open up the hive and inspect it. That inspection provides the beekeeper a chance to observe and evaluate the healthy and unhealthy things going on internally.

Our inspection this morning centers on the hive as a whole entity, but we must keep in mind that there is a similar inspection required for us as individuals. Jesus provided an example of this in Matthew 23 when he pronounced seven woes on the scribes and Pharisees. Many of those woes had to do with making the internal and external person match. Even today, too many Christians, "clean the outside of the cup and plate (Mt. 23:25)," but remain dirty internally. "You blind Pharisee! First clean the inside ... that the outside also may be clean (Mt. 23:26)."

I pray our introspection regarding the hive will lead to healthier life inside the hive and to better relationships with God and one another. May God bless our every effort to be the hive that seeks to reflect Him in every way.
