

On Tuesday a Dallas jury found Amber Guyger guilty of the murder of former Harding student Botham Jean. She faced up to life in prison, but was sentenced to 10 years. The most amazing thing happened Wednesday at her sentencing as Botham's brother, Brandt, had the opportunity to speak to the murderer. Many times the family of the victim uses the opportunity to say hateful and mean things as their raw emotions erupt to the surface. What happened instead was a remarkable scene, and I encourage you to watch the video on the internet. The 18-year-old Brandt extended forgiveness to Guyger and encouraged her to come to Christ. Then he gave her a hug.

Here is a partial transcript of what Brandt said:

If you truly are sorry, ... I forgive, and I know if you go to God and ask him, he will forgive you. And I don't think anyone can say it-again I'm speaking for myself-but I love you just like anyone else. And I'm not gonna say I hope you rot and die just like my brother did, but I presently want the best for you. And I wasn't going to ever say this in front of my family or anyone, but I don't even want you to go to jail. I want the best for you, because I know that's exactly what Botham would want you to do. And the best would be to give your life to Christ. I'm not going to say anything else. I think giving your life to Christ would be the best thing that Botham would want you to do.






