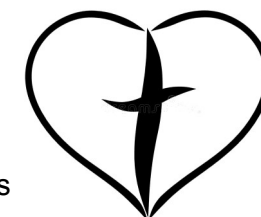

### Questions on Hebrews



Last Sunday evening's introduction to Hebrews has spawned some questions I know would be beneficial for us all to investigate. We discussed the passages that warn against apostasy (turning away from Christ), and the questions I received represent very important matters. Do those passage mean we can lose our salvation? Is it possible to fall from God's grace? If so, what does that mean exactly? Are we then destined for Hell? If we return to a life of sin, some people would teach that we were never Christians to begin with. Is that true, and what do we do with that teaching? Are there examples in the Bible for us to learn from?

This morning, we allow the Bible to speak to this important subject, and I freely admit it is a topic that is very controversial within Christianity. Frequently, tempers flare and emotions take over the conversation. That commonly means our ears close and our hearts harden to what is being said because we want to hear only what we already believe or have been taught previously. I pray these things not happen to us in any way this morning as we listen to the Bible.

I encourage you to pay close attention, take notes, and continue to study on your own because there is much to cover and the stakes are high. If it is true that we can fall from grace, there are many walking this earth who believe they are saved but walk in darkness, and it would certainly please Satan (the deceiver) for a multitude of people to be filled with false security and no longer even be concerned about their salvation. If it is true, it also means we must remain diligent to make our selection sure by walking in the light so the blood of Christ will continue to cleanse us from sin (read 1 John 1:7 and notice the use of the word "if" as John writes to Christians).

May God bless our efforts on this and every morning as we seek after His truth.
