Qualities of an Elder

Qualities instead of Qualifications (1 Tim. 3:1-7; Titus 1:5-16)

- 1. Two common, unhealthy approaches applying the text
- 2. Historical background (Ephesus vs. Crete)
- 3. Most qualities apply to every Christian

Three Groupings of Qualities

God desires the elder to...


- 1. ...be respected, dignified, and above reproach in both the local church and local community.
- 2. ...have established a life worthy of imitation (most easily seen in leading his own family).
- 3. ...be a capable teacher of His Word who can use its principles to shepherd the flock.

Qualities from Timothy and Titus

above reproach/blameless good reputation with outsiders not quick-tempered temperate no drunkard not violent not quarrelsome not greedy not a recent convert lover of good upright disciplined self-controlled respectable hospitable not overbearing or self-will

holy husband of one wife ("one woman's man")

apt to teach/hold firm to the trust-worthy message manage his family well, having submissive, respectful children ("believers")




