My Duty to the Elder

Today's lesson supplementing our 40 Days of Prayer about elders shifts the focus toward the members of God's family. Duties and Responsibilities of the Christian Toward an Elder

Introduction: The elder assists in developing a healthy, encouraging environment so each person grows to full spiritual maturity in Christ (Eph. 4:11-13).

I. Duties and responsibilities

- Respect and esteem him very highly in love (1 Thess. 5:12-13)
- Remember...Consider...Imitate his faith (Heb. 13:7)
- Obey and submit (Heb. 17:3)
- Pray (1 Tim. 2:1-2)
 - He will follow God's truth
 - He will be courageous
 - Many others... wisdom, spiritual wellbeing, His family, etc.
- Promote peace and unity in the church (Matt. 5:9)
 - Reconciliation and forgiveness (Gal. 6:1; Col. 3:13)
 - Communication (Eph. 4:29; Col. 3:8)
 - Remove negativity; encourage positivity (Eph. 4:3; Phil. 4:8-9)

I hope to come to you soon, but I am writing these things to you so that, if I delay, you may know how one ought to behave in the household of God, which is the church of the living God, a pillar and buttress of the truth.
