Today we begin to supplement our 40 Days of Prayer concerning elders with our first discussion about the need and work of an elder. Please take the basic outline of today's sermon and study and pray over each point this week. Take time to learn more about the work and the need of elders in the church.

Why study?

- 1) It is a part of the whole council of God (Acts 20:27).
- 2) Our current eldership deems it good (1 Pet. 5:1-3; Acts 20:28).
- 3) To protect the future of this congregation (1 Pet. 5:2-3; Heb. 13:7, 17)

Three ways the need for elders is seen:

- 1) It is what God desires as understood through NT commands and examples (Acts 14:22-23; Titus 1:5; 1 Tim. 3:1-7).
- 2) God has laid out duties for an elder (also known in the NT as: presbyter, bishop, overseer, pastor, shepherd)
 - a. feed and tend the flock (Acts 20:28, 1 Pet. 5:1-4)
 - b. watch for false teachers (Acts 20:29-30, Heb. 13:17)
 - c. rule in the household of God (1 Tim. 5:17)
 - d. lead diligently (Rom. 12:8)
- 3) Dangers arise when no elders exist or existing elders are not doing their duty (Tim.4:1-3; Titus 1:10-16; Gal. 1:10).

May God bless our every effort to honor Him and His will for us throughout this process.


LADIES' DAY:
